

All-Star Revue Information

The All-Star Revue is back for another year. Under the direction of Mrs. Mary L. Murphy, this amazing program has been a part of the PTA's program offerings for over 30 years. Throughout these years this wonderful program has developed a love and interest in theater, boosted confidence and self-esteem, introduced students to Theater Education and has fostered a love of the Performing Arts in general.

Below is some general information about this wonderful program and auditions and registration information.

There are 2 fees to participate in All-Star Revue:

- A \$65 Registration fee (includes participation t-shirt given to all participants), \$45 for sibling (scholarships are available for those in need)
- A \$10/\$15 PTA membership fee (if you are already a current member of the PTA you are not required to pay this again).

Auditions will be held Saturday, October 28 at 9:00, 10:00 and 11:00 am and Monday, October 30 at 4:30 and 5:30 pm.

The auditions are so that Mrs. Murphy can place performers in a scene(s) that embrace their individual strengths. and to achieve a balanced production. *Everyone that auditions will be a part of the production.* The auditions are simply to place students in scenes that best fit their schedules and talents.

A mandatory Parent/Caregiver Meeting will take place on Thursday, November 2 at 6:00pm at BIS.

The following information will be presented and shared and at this meeting:

- Detailed Rehearsal schedule - Rehearsals will be held primarily at Bourne Intermediate School. Individual scene rehearsals will start at 4:30 on Mondays and Thursdays after school in 45-60 minute time slots with the last rehearsal ending by 7:30, and group rehearsals for everyone will be held on either Wednesdays at 6:30, or Fridays at 4:30. There will be occasional Saturday morning rehearsals.
- Dress rehearsals and performance information. The Performances will be on Friday, February 9 at 6:00 pm and Saturday, February 10 at 1:00 pm.
- All parents/caregivers of All Stars are required to donate a total of 3 hours of rehearsal help and/or help with some aspect of All-Star Revue. All volunteers are required to be CORI certified with the Bourne School District (even if you have one for scouts or coaching). We will need several Lead Volunteers that will take on more responsibilities and receive a waiver for the registration fee.

Expectations

- In order to ensure rehearsals are a productive and positive experience for all, please make note of the following expectation regarding negative behaviors. Any student who is engaging in behaviors such as being disrespectful and not listening to adult prompts will be asked to leave rehearsal; this first time will serve as a warning. If the student is asked to leave rehearsal for a second time, for the same reasons, they will no longer be able to participate in All Star Revue.
- We cannot provide childcare outside of rehearsal time. If you are more than 5 minutes late picking up your child a fee will be charged \$1 per minute.
- Performers will need a white button down shirt, either a pair of black pants or a black skirt, and a pair of ALL black shoes (cannot have a white or colored bottom). If you do not have either of these please let us know and we can check our "costume closet".
