



All-Star Revue Contract

Please read completely and sign the bottom.

Commitment

Participating in the All-Star Revue requires commitment, from you and your child. This commitment lasts for about ten (10) weeks (depending on enrollment) from early November to the performance in early February. This will ensure your child and other children in the program enjoy the best dramatic experience possible. **It is extremely important that your child attend each rehearsal**, as it will help their confidence and affect how comfortable they are in their number. Any child missing more than one (1) rehearsal for unexcused reasons may be removed from key roles (i.e. a solo, a dance or speaking part) in the show. Any child missing more than two (2) rehearsals for unexcused reasons may be removed from the show entirely. Sickness is an excused absence. Family vacations, hockey practice or Red Sox tickets, for example, are not.

If your child is involved in other activities that conflict with the All-Star Revue (especially the week in February before the performances), your family may have to choose between the All-Star Revue and the other activity. Efforts will be made to work with known conflicts.

Dismissal

Dismissal will be promptly at the scheduled time per the rehearsal calendar (changes to rehearsal times will be sent through email and posted at the sign-in table). Please make every effort to pick up your child on time. We understand that emergencies arise and bridge traffic can be a nightmare at times, but please make every effort to arrive on time or call us when you know otherwise. If you are more than 5 minutes late a fee will be charged \$1.00 per minute.

Children **MUST** be signed out by an adult (over 18 years of age). This is a safety issue and we hope you understand why it is an absolute necessity.

PTA Membership

Your PTA Membership must be current before the first group rehearsal (November). You may register online or on paper by going to www.bournepta.weebly.com. One family member must be a Bourne PTA member in order for your child(ren) to participate in this program. This is non-refundable.

Behavioral Expectations

In order to ensure rehearsals are a productive and positive experience for all, please make note of the following expectation regarding negative behaviors. Any student who is engaging in behaviors such as being disrespectful and not listening to adult prompts will be asked to leave rehearsal; this first time will serve as a warning. If the student is asked to leave rehearsal for a second time, for the same reasons, they will no longer be able to participate in All Star Revue.

Parent Volunteers

This program can only be a success with the help of MANY hands. We require the help of every cast member's parent/guardian. **You will be required to fulfill at least three (3) hours of volunteer service.** There are many ways to help:

- Helping with Student Oversight (Sign-in/out table, Free time monitor, etc.)*
- Back Stage Activities (Helping with costume changes, hair & make-up, etc.)*
 - Will receive preferential seating during the performance they attend in the audience.
- Costume Coordination (Gathering items for costumes, working with seamstress, do not have to know how to sew.)*
- Making Baked Goods or donating water
- Staffing Bake/Flower/T-shirt Table During a Performance
- Soliciting & Collecting Ads for the Program
